
Bayview Reception is open between the following hours:

If you are arriving outside of these hours you will need a key safe code to obtain your apartment keys and gain access to the carpark.



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<u>Monday – Friday:</u>

Check In Time is between 2pm and 5pm.

Early Check In's are subject to availability. When available, Check-In from 12pm may be offered free of charge. Any Check-In earlier than 12pm will incur a fee equivalent to a half night rate.

Please come to Bayview Reception located at 22 Bay Street, Byron Bay to Check In and collect your keys.

If you are arriving prior to 2pm, you are welcome to come to reception where we can arrange luggage and/or parking. Subject to staffing levels, we will endeavour to have your apartment ready for you as early as possible, but cannot guarantee an early check in.

If you are arriving after 5pm, please contact our office on (02) 6685 7073 or <u>info@byronbayview.com.au</u> before 3pm on your arrival day for Late Arrival Instructions.

Saturday & Sunday:

Check In Time is from 2pm.

As our office closes at 12 noon on a Saturday & Sunday, you may need to use our afterhours check-in procedure (explained next page).

Your apartment will be ready for you from 2pm on your day of arrival, but you are quite welcome to park your car from 12pm. Please don't enter the apartment prior to 2pm.

Late Check in Instructions

If you are arriving outside of Bayview Apartments office opening hours, you will need to follow our afterhours check-in procedure.

When arriving after hours, you cannot gain access to Bayview Apartments by driving directly to the car park.

<u>Please come FIRST to Reception located at 22 Bay Street</u> where you will find a key safe on the Left Hand Side of the reception door (see adjacent photo).

You will receive your code via text & email prior to your arrival.

Inside the key safe you will find an envelope containing:

- your keys for the car park and your apartment
- apartment & car park directions

Once you have collected your envelope, you can proceed to the car park (see page 7 & 8)

Please come to reception the following morning to complete your check in.

Car Parking Information

Strictly 1 car space per apartment (height restriction 2m) No parking allowed in Staff Car Park at the rear of the complex. All other vehicles must park offsite. Charges will apply for unauthorised additional cars. Please be aware that you are parking in the Bayview carpark at your own risk. Please take care if you are parking near the garage door.

Carpark access


Bayview Carpark is accessible from Bay Lane, which is located directly behind Bayview and running parallel to Bay Street. Both Bay Lane and Bay Street are one way (in the same direction) therefore you will need to access Bay Lane from Fletcher Street (see map on page 8)

Your apartment key will unlock the gate. Please ensure you park in your allocated apartment space. From the carpark, you can access your apartment using the appropriate stairwell.

To exit you only need to drive up to the gate and it will automatically open.

Carparking after check out:

Subject to availability, we may be able to allow you to keep your car in the carpark until 11am on your day of check out. If your car is not moved by 11am there will be a charge of \$11 per hour, or part hour, from 10am and your vehicle may be towed.



Apartment Information:

At Bayview we are classed as self-contained accommodation.

All linen and bath towels are supplied.

Each apartment is equipped with a full kitchen with cooking facilities:

Including:

- Stove tops
- Ovens (some apartments may not have an oven)
- Microwave
- All kitchen utensils


We do supply a starter pack for your first night which includes toilet paper, soap, tea, coffee, sugar, UHT milk, dish cloth, dishwasher tablets, small packets of laundry powder. It is the responsibility of the guest to replenish these items, as we do not service the apartments unless staying 8 nights or more. *please note we do not supply shampoo and conditioner.

Bayview reception has a few of these items for sale for your convenience if you cannot make it to a supermarket (see page 8 for a map of supermarket locations).

Supermarkets:

There are 3 local supermarkets located quite close by.

- Spar supermarket is in Lawson Street near the corner of Jonson Street.
- Aldi is located on Byron Street between Fletcher & Jonson Streets.
- Woolworths is in the Mercato Centre at 108-114 Jonson Street.



Check out Procedure:

We hope you have enjoyed your stay with us at Bayview. We ask you to please consider these check out guidelines;

Check out is at 10am on the day of departure. Please understand that we clean apartments between 10am and 2pm to prepare for incoming guests and therefore Late Check-Out's are strictly subject to availability and must be pre-arranged with reception. Additional charges may apply.

Before you check out please ensure:

- 1. all rubbish is removed from the apartment. Garbage and recycle bins are located in the carpark at the bottom of Stairwell C. Additional bins are located in the lane way. We ask you to please recycle.
- 2. Load dishwasher with all dirty dishes and start the cycle.
- 3. Cook tops and benches wiped over.
- 4. Any damages to the apartment will be charged at current trade rates

<u>Please note</u>: if the apartment is left in an untidy state an extra cleaning fee will be charged at the managers discretion to your credit card.

Once you have checked out of your apartment, you are very welcome to continue to use Bayview's facilities. There is a toilet located in the basement car park, behind carpark #23, and a cold shower in the pool area. We are very happy to store luggage should you require it. Please be aware that, while we do our best to monitor luggage, it is stored in our luggage compartment at your own risk.

Use of Portacots & rollaway Beds

We have portacots, baby packs and rollaway beds for hire for your extra guests. All hire items are subject to the below conditions;

Rollaway beds: \$45 per night. Linen included.

<u>Portacots</u>: \$55 for length of stay for children under 2years of age. Linen included.

Baby pack: \$66 for length of stay. Includes a portacot, highchair and baby bath. Linen included.



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Swimming Pool

Our swimming pool is located on street level and is fully fenced with sun lounges and umbrellas.

Pool hours are between 7am and 8pm.

We do not allow sun lounges to be reserved. If you have left a towel etc on the lounges to hold them, it will be removed by staff.

The swimming pool is heated through winter to approximately 27° Celsius, between April and October. Please note that these dates are subject to local weather conditions and may change.

All children must be under adult supervision at all times. We ask that beach toys such as body boards and noodles not be used in the pool as they can interfere with the filtration system.

For safety reasons, STRICTLY NO glass or alcohol is allowed in the pool area.

Please do not climb on the walls surrounding the pool. The rock wall is a feature wall and is not designed to be climbed on. The rocks can be easily displaced when grabbed.

Pool/Beach towels

We have pool/beach towels for hire from the Bayview reception @ \$2.50 + \$10 refundable bond. This is payable with cash or credit card. Your bond is refunded when the towel is returned to reception.



Beach Equipment:

We have a storage compartment that contains a variety of beach equipment such as beach chairs, toys and umbrellas. Please remove all sand from these items before returning them to the storage facility. We kindly ask that items are put back neatly where they were found. Please be aware that this equipment is used at your own risk. We ask that body boards, noodles, sand toys etc are not taken into the pool area.

Barbeque Area

The BBQ area is in the centre courtyard of Bayview Apartments. The communal BBQ area is available for the enjoyment of all Bayview guests. Please ensure the BBQ is turned off after use and the BBQ and surrounding area are left clean for the next guests. There are cleaning supplies provided near and under the sink.

For the consideration of all Bayview guests, we ask that all guests please vacate the communal areas by 10pm.

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Shopping:

Byron Bay has a huge array of shopping options, ranging from retail outlets such as Sports Girl to huge surf shops to local brands such as Spell Design. As you walk the streets of Byron Bay you will discover clothing, jewellery, sporting, homewares and more. Be sure to venture off the main drag to find some beautiful local stores.

There are some amazing stores very close to Bayview Apartments; <u>Arnhem Clothing</u>: Local, sustainable female & children's clothes <u>Golden Breed</u>: Local beach clothing & accessories – Men, Women & Children <u>Kivari</u>: Australian women's fashion.

Byron Surf: Surf brand clothing & accessories – Men, Women & Children. The Book Room: Local book store with huge range, gifts and coffee.

The new Mercato centre in Byron has a Livelife Pharmacy, Reject Shop, Bed Bath & Table and Woolworths as well as several dining options. It is also the home to the Palace Cinemas.

There are several options if you wish to do food/grocery shopping; (See map on page 8)

Spar Convenience Store: located on the main intersection between Lawson & Jonson Streets, very close to Bayview with everything you would expect from a convenience store.

Woolworths: located at the new Mercato on Jonson Street with underground parking.

Aldi: Located in the centre of town on Byron Street, Aldi gives you another option for a supermarket

There is also a diverse range of shopping available at the Byron Arts & Industry Estate. It is located a walkable 3km from town (with free street parking available) and offers a huge range of arts, industry, food and shopping. Visit <u>byronartstrail.com</u> to discover a comprehensive guide to Byron's best art, artisans & ateliers. There is an easy to follow map outlining the trail which leads you on a tour of artist studios, galleries, shops and workshops.



It is indisputable that an absolute highlight of any trip to Byron Bay is experiencing the world-famous beaches. And there is certainly no shortage of options:

Main Beach: Simply stroll across the road from Bayview and you have stumbled upon Byron's Main Beach. It is a pretty, sandy beach with a patrolled flagged area and views straight out to the famous Julian Rocks.

The Wreck: The Wreck is an icon of Byron Bay surf culture. Located just west of Main Beach, and barely a few minutes' walk from Bayview Apartments, this very photogenic spot should not be missed. Whilst the beach does get quite busy during peak times, the people watching is superb and the sheltered corner created by the rock wall makes for great swimming conditions.

Clarkes Beach: Nestled in the corner of the Bay between Main Beach and The Pass is Clarkes Beach. An extension of Main Beach, Clarkes Beach is another beautiful spot that may offer some escape from the crowds. At high tide it offers great swimming without any big waves to battle and low tide often creates a great lagoon for lazing. There are a few rocks around, so watch your feet when walking.

The Pass: The Pass is iconic. And not just an icon of Byron Bay. It is an internationally recognised image of Australia. The never-ending wave, the infinite lines of swell, the lookout perfectly situated to admire it all. Whilst the sand and surf can both get very crowded, The Pass is worth a visit. There is space to spread out, safe swimming and pretty rock pools to explore. It is tucked away in the corner of The Bay, often providing a perfect escape from the wind. An easy, flat walk from Bayview apartments or a very short drive and you will see.









Wategos: Just around the point from The Pass is Wategos beach. Famous for its luxurious mansions and celebrity spotting, a trip to Wategos should be on any to-do list. It is stunningly photogenic and a wonderful place to let a sunny day roll by. Wategos is also known for its great surf conditions-recommended for experienced surfers only.

Belongil Beach: If you want to walk a stretch of sandy beach where you will pass only a handful of people and a puppy or two (it is leash-free), head north past The Wreck and keep on walking. The crowds will thin and you'll feel alone in the best possible way. While Belongil is unpatrolled and slightly more dangerous for swimming, it is perfect for sunset walks, sunbaking and beach games.



Tallow Beach: Tallow beach is located approximately 3km from Byron's town centre in the Arakwal National Park. It is a beautiful sandy beach with opportunities for whale watching, bird watching, beach fishing, sunbaking and swimming. The beach is unpatrolled and can have strong rips so recommended for experienced surfers only.

Broken Head Beach: Broken Head beach is approximately 10mins drive from Byron Bay. Protected by its own headland, Broken head beach is a favourite with families- local & visiting- for swimming, surfing and fishing. There is also an open grassy area nearby with picnic tables, barbeques and amenities making it a perfect day trip from Byron. It is patrolled at various times throughout the year.

Byron Hinterland & Neighbouring Towns:

If you need a break from the beach, or the weather isn't cooperating, there are many amazing areas to explore just outside of Byron Bay;

Newrybar: Located 20 minutes' drive from Bayview Apartments, Newrybar is an historic, one-street-town surround by stunning hinterland. While a simple drive through town is beautiful enough, the shops & cafes make for a day well spent. Be sure to check out <u>Harvest</u>, <u>Newrybar Merchants</u>, <u>Drift Lab</u> and <u>Gaia Retreat & Spa</u>.

Bangalow: Essentially, Bangalow is the ultimate small town. Great shops, amazing food, beautiful scenery & a creative local population. Just 15 minutes from Byron Bay, Bangalow is a great option for a morning drive with plenty of potential to turn into a full day adventure. We recommend <u>Butcher, Baker, Bangalow</u>, <u>One Green Acre</u> and <u>Our Corner</u> <u>Store</u>.


Brunswick Heads: Brunswick township is excuse enough to leave the bustle of Byrondelicious food (don't miss <u>Old Maids Burger Store</u>), local shopping and a great pub; <u>Hotel</u> <u>Brunswick</u>. However, add the fact that Brunswick River is one of the best swimming spots in the area and there is no excuse not to go. The 25 minute drive will feel like nothing as soon as you get there.

Lennox Head: venture a few beaches south of Byron and you'll find Lennox Heads. A stunning town with incredible beaches (the famous Seven Mile Beach starts here) plus the beautiful Lake Ainsworth- a huge tea tree lake, perfect for swimming. Famous for its surfing breaks, but there is much more to Lennox and well worth a visit.





Waterfalls:



Minyon Falls: Located in the stunning Nightcap National Park, Minyon falls is, rightfully, Byron's most famous waterfalls. They plunge more than 100 meters over jagged cliffs to the pools below. There are 2 hiking option for visitors seeking the full experience, the short option taking around 2 hours and the longer option between 4 & 5 hours. There is also an easily accessible viewing platform offering panoramic views from the top. This stunning hinterland experience is just 45 minutes drive from Bayview.

Killen Falls: Killen falls can be found at Tintenbar, around 30 minutes drive from Bayview. There is an easily accessible viewing platform from the top, or a 1km return hike to the base where visitors can walk behind the cascading water.



Protestors Falls: Named for the 1970s Terenia Creek protests which saved this part of the pristine rainforest, Protestors falls reside in the World heritage listed Nightcap National Park. The looped walking track is around 1.5km long and is a great option for families. Protestors Falls is a stunning 1 hour 20 minute drive through Byron's hinterland.

Cape Byron Lighthouse

The Cape Byron Lighthouse walk is a Byron Bay experience not to be missed! It is a stunning hike by the beach, through rainforest & across clifftops with incredible ocean and hinterland views along the way. Be prepared for some incredible wildlife encounters too! Here is some essential information for you;

Distance: 3.7km

Difficulty: Grade 3 – Medium. The track can be accessed at numerous points to make it shorter and easier

with limited paid parking available at certain stages (see map).

Time Suggested: 1.5-3hrs (full loop from Bayview)



Cafes: There are 2 cafes that provide perfect rest stops along the way; The Pass Cafe, located at The Pass and Cape Byron Lighthouse Cafe, located at the lighthouse.

Lookouts: Offering unbeatable views, the lookouts on the way to the lighthouse are not to be missed. Be sure to stop at Captain Cook's Lookout & Fisherman's Lookout (see map).

Picnic Spots: There are multiple picnic spots along the way: Captain's Cook Lookout, The Pass, Wategos Beach, Little Wategos Beach and The Lighthouse (see map).

Parking: There is 1-hour maximum parking at the lighthouse car park for \$8.00. There is 1 hour maximum parking for \$4.00 at the lower lighthouse car parks. There is 4 hour parking at Wategos and The Pass for \$4.00 per hour. There is unlimited parking at Clarke's Beach for \$4.00 per hour (capped at \$20.00 for all day parking).

Other Information: As it is a National Park, the lighthouse is non-smoking and pets/domestic animals are not allowed (service animals excluded). There are toilets located at various stages along the track (see map). The Maritime Museum (former Lighthouse Keeper's office) is open 10am-4pm daily.

Don't forget to take some drinking water, a hat, sunscreen & a camera.

Directions (see map): From Bayview Apartments, you can either follow the road or the beach towards the lighthouse.

If following the beach, walk east along Main Beach, past Clarkes Beach, to The Pass. At The Pass walk off the beach and follow the track to the lighthouse, it is well signed. You will pass Wategos Beach before climbing the stairs to the lighthouse.

If following the road, turn right out of Bayview and follow the path found across the road. Continue on this path, along Lighthouse road, following the signs to Cape Byron Lighthouse.
